ORDER:

In G.O.Ms.No.2131, EST dated 29.9.1982, the Government have decided to permit private managements to start and run Polytechnics on self-financing basis, subject to the conditions laid down therein. Subsequently, in G.O.Ms. No.2007, EST dated 18.10.1983, the Government have revised the conditions as follows, for starting self-financing Private Polytechnics.

- 1) The managements which open such new private Polytechnics without any financial commitment to Government shall be allowed to admit candidates upto 50% of the approved intake under management quota, subject to observance of the rules and the remaining 50% should be filled up strictly on merit basis as per the guidelines issued by the Government and the Director of Technical Education from time to time.
- 2) The managements of the private polytechnics should scrupulously follow the admission rules such as minimum marks, qualification etc. that are prescribed by Government and the Director of Technical Education from time to time while admitting candidates .
- 3) The demand for the Technical personnel in the surrounding areas should be assessed for introducing the nature of courses and for fixing the annual intake. The location of such Polytechnics should be on the basis of the backwardness of the area.

4) The management should provide an Endowment Fund to the tune of Rs.10/- lakhs in cash, jointly in the name of a Trust formed for the purpose and in the name of the Director of Technical Education. The endowment fund of Rs.10/- lakhs (Rupees Ten lakhs only) can be created either in one lump-sum, before starting of the Polytechnic or in instalments as detailed below:-

I Year	(before opening of the Polytechnic	Rs.4/- lakhs

The money should be invested in the Nationalised Bank/Scheduled Bank/Government of India undertakings/State Government Undertakings whichever the Trust may prefer. The income from the Endowment Fund should be utilised fully to meet the recurring and non-recurring expenditure of the institution without expecting any aid from the Government for any purpose at any time, now or in future.

5) In addition, the Private managements should produce either a Bank Guarantee for a period of 5 years to the tune of Rs.10/- lakhs or a Solvency Certificate to the above extent obtained from the competent Revenue authority, before opening of the Polytechnic.

6) In regard to provision of land, it was considered that considering the present day cost, 50 acres of land may not be available and it was therefore decided that the following minimum extent of land should be provided by the private managements:-

I. Municipal/Town/City areas:-

(a) Men's Polytechnic : 15 acres
 (b) Women's Polytechnic : 10 acres

II. Rural areas:-

(a) Men's Polytechnic : 25 acres
 (b) Women's Polytechnic : 15 acres

The management should produce documentary evidence for their possession of 50% of the lands before opening of the Polytechnic. The remaining 50% of the lands should be provided within 2 years from the date of establishment of the Polytechnic.

7) The staff recruitment should conform to the rules and orders issued by the Government for Government Aided Polytechnics.

8) The Workshops and Laboratories are to be equipped as per the required standards.

9) The new private Polytechnics so established should be under the control of the Director of Technical Education

and periodical review/inspection should also be done by the Director of Technical Education.

- 10) The private managements which created an Endowment of Rs.10/- Lakhs in one lump-sum, before starting of the Polytechnic shall be allowed to start three or more Diploma courses, and the managements which create Endowments in instalments as specified in condition (4) above, shall be allowed to start only upto 3 Diploma courses, with an overall intake of not more than 180 students.
- 11) No additional courses/Increase in intake shall be allowed unless the private managements create Endowment to the tune of Rs.10/- lakhs in full.
- 12) The private managements should execute an agreement in a stamp paper of the value of Rs.2.50 agreeing to abide by all the conditions laid in this Government order.
- 13) The management should also give separate undertaking stating that NO CAPITATION FEE will be collected from the students seeking admission in the above Polytechnic.
- 14) The Tuition fees and Special Fees should be collected from the students as in the case of Government Polytechnics or as directed by the Government from time to time.
- 15) The Government also stipulate that if the conditions are not fulfilled by the private managements so permitted the permission granted is liable to be withdrawn at any time. The Government will have the right to takeover the Polytechnic in question at any time with all its immovable and moveable properties including Endowment and cash balances without paying any compensation.

2. Accordingly, the Director of Technical Education has submitted proposals with necessary documentary evidences, for the establishment of K.S. Rangasamy Institute of Technology, Tiruchengode, Salem District, with effect from 1984-85 by K.S.R. Institute of Technology Trust, Tiruchengode, without involving any financial commitment to Government for ever.

3. The Government after careful consideration permit the establishment of "K.S. Rangasamy Institute of Technology, Tiruchengode, Salem District, with the following courses, with effect from 1984-85 subject to the conditions laid hereunder:-

COURSES	INTAKE
(1) Diploma course in Civil Engineering	60 students
(2) Diploma course in Mechanical Engineering	60 students
(3) Diploma course in Electronics & Communication Engineering	60 students

CONDITIONS:

- (i) The management of the above Polytechnic should abide by all the conditions mentioned in para 1 above.
- (ii) The management should purchase the remaining 14.38 acres of lands as required in para 1 (6) above and produce documentary evidence for their possession, within 2 years from the date of establishment of the above Polytechnic.
- (iii) The Tuition fees and Special fees should be collected from the students as per the rules prevailing in Government Polytechnics or as directed by Government from time to time.
- (iv) The management should complete all preliminary arrangements before the end of the academic year 1983-84 and start the Polytechnic from the academic year 1984-85 onwards.

4. The Director of Technical Education is requested to ensure that all the conditions prescribed by Government are scrupulously followed by the above mentioned management. If any violation is noticed, the Director of Technical Education should bring it to the notice of the Government forth-with.

The Institution offering courses earlier in the Regular Shift, First Shift, Second Shift/Part Time are now amalgamated as total intake and shall have to fulfil all facilities such as Infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2024-25 to 2027 for the Total Approved Intake.

4. In case of any differences in content in this Computer generated Extension of Approval Letter, the content/information as approved by the **Executive Council / General Council as available on the record of AICTE shall be final and binding.**
